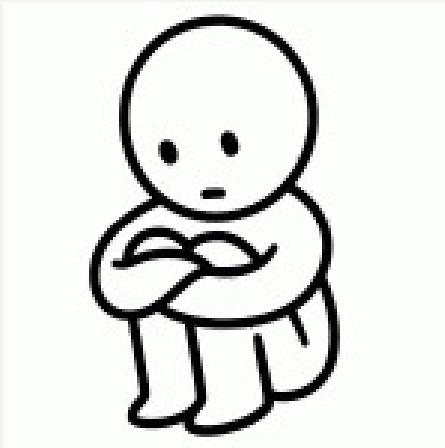
What will happen?

Please we need your support to be able to take care of our 300 + dogs in the shelter.

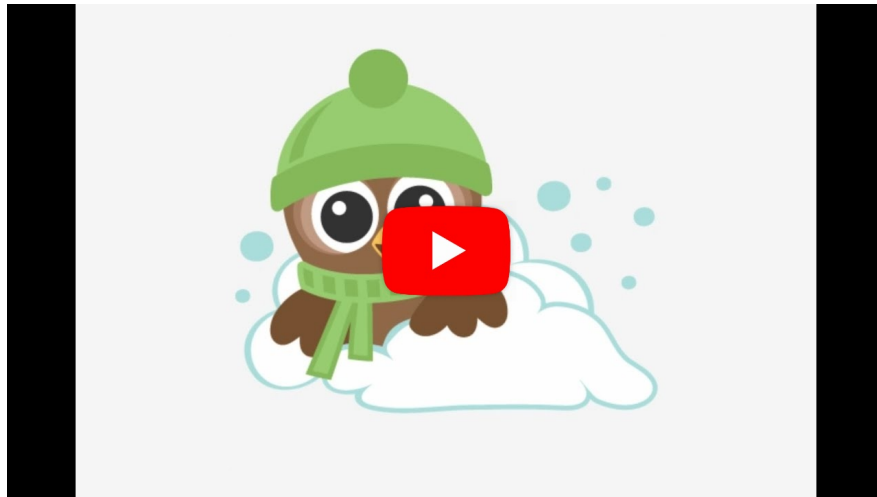
If you can think of a way to help us or know of a generous benefactor who can then please contact us. Maybe you know a business that can help?

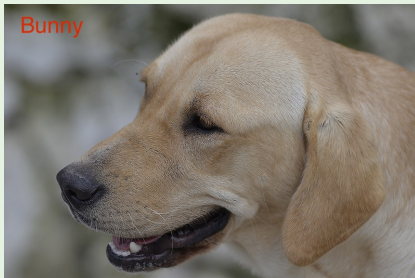

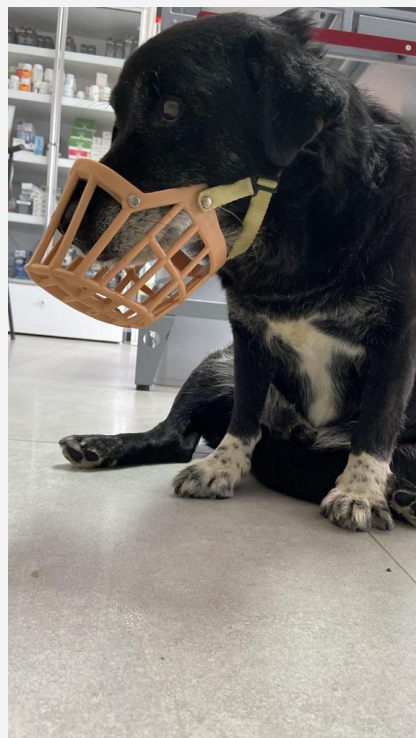
Much Loved Street Dog Mario Injured

Many local people will recognise Mario this lovely black and white dog who has been a regular face in Gocek for some time now.

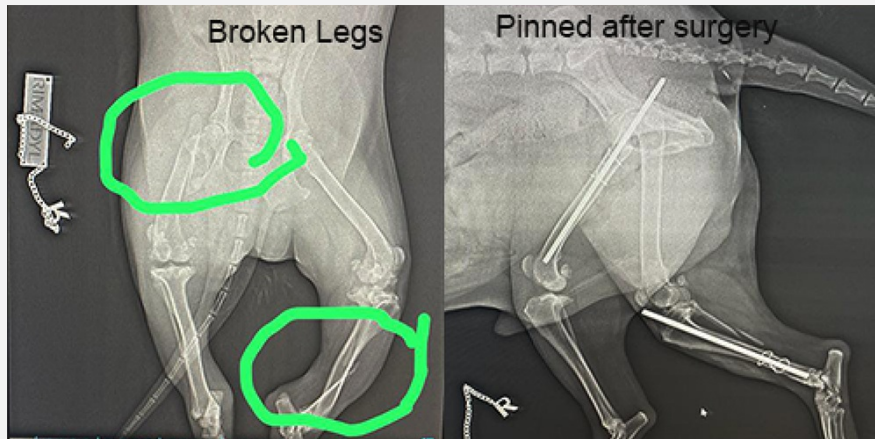
Some while ago we arranged for him to get some treatment and sterilisation at the vet but he had been so happy on the street before that we decided to let him go back there instead of taking her to the shelter.

He spent most of his time lying in the sun by the harbour or moving from restaurant to restaurant to sample the different menus on offer. He was no trouble to anyone and seemed to enjoy a happy life.

Unfortunately, he must have decided to venture a bit further afield and not being used to traffic was hit by a car and broke both his rear legs. He is now at the vet being cared for.
